

Glue Art Rubbings

What you need:

- A bottle of white school glue
- A piece of thick paper, card stock, or thin cardboard (the back or front of an empty cereal box will work)
- A pencil
- White copier paper
- Crayons

What you do:

1. Use a pencil to draw a design or picture on the thick paper, card stock, or thin cardboard. Try geometric shapes, the letters of your name, or any design or picture you like!
2. Trace over the lines of your drawing with a thin line of glue.
3. Allow the glue to dry completely.
4. Place a piece of white copier paper over the design or picture.
5. Rub a crayon back and forth over the paper, creating a rubbing.
6. Try making several different rubbings of your design or picture, using different crayon colors or a combination of colors.
